Absence

If your child is unable to come to school you must inform the school of their absence by 9.30am either at the office in person, or on 01782973800. Please leave a message on the answer machine if no-one is available to take your call.

Attendance is continuously monitored and any absence without reason is classed as unauthorised.



Sickness

If your child is sick they must be kept off school for 48 hours after the last time they were sick to help ensure the bug is not passed on to other children.
