



# Leaping Literacy

## Word Reading

Decoding	I can use picture clues to help me read simple texts.
	<u>I can read aloud accurately books that are consistent with my developing phonic knowledge</u>
	<u>I can read accurately by blending sounds in unfamiliar words</u>
	<u>I can use phonic knowledge and skills to decode and blend sounds together to read words, including long phonemes.</u>
	I can read familiar endings to words, s, es, ing, ed, er, est.
	I can read the common exception words for Year 1 and I am learning them from the Year 2 list.
	<u>I can respond speedily with the correct sound to grapheme for all 40+ phonemes</u>
	<u>I can recognise and use the different ways of pronouncing the same grapheme e.g ow in snow and cow</u>
I can read words with more than 1 syllable and can count the syllables.	
I can read words with contractions e.g I'm, I'll, we'll etc	

## Comprehension

Range of reading	I can link what I read or hear to my own experiences, with encouragement.
	I can listen to a wide range of poems, stories and non-fiction books.
	<u>I can choose my own books/stories to read and say why I have chosen it verbally and in written form</u>
	I can participate in discussions <i>and record</i> about what is read to me and take turns.
	<u>I can listen to what others say</u>
Familiarity with texts	<u>I can recognise the difference between fiction and non-fiction.</u>
	<u>I can recall and write about specific information in fiction and non-fiction texts</u>
	I can become very familiar with key stories, fairy stories and traditional tales, and can retell verbally and in written form.

Word Meaning	I can recognise obvious story language, example, once upon a time, big bad wolf.
	I can recognise repetition of language in my reading.
	I can discuss what new words mean, linking new meanings to those already known.
Understanding	<u>I can identify and discuss the main events or key points in stories</u>
	<u>I can identify and discuss the main characters in stories</u>
	<u>I can answer questions on a text I have read relating to who, what, where, when, why and how</u>
	<u>I know when my reading doesn't make sense. I can self correct.</u>
Inference	I can express opinions verbally and in written form about mains events and characters in a story.
	I can recognise verbally and in written form why a character is feeling a certain way.
Poetry & Performance	I can appreciate rhymes and poems, and can recite some by heart.
	I can use drama and role play to retell stories and take on the role of a character
Prediction	<u>I can make predictions verbally and in written form based on what I have read so far</u>
