It's the last week of Term. Well done everyone for completing the online learning! This weeks work looks different because it's the last week I have provided some fun activities for you!

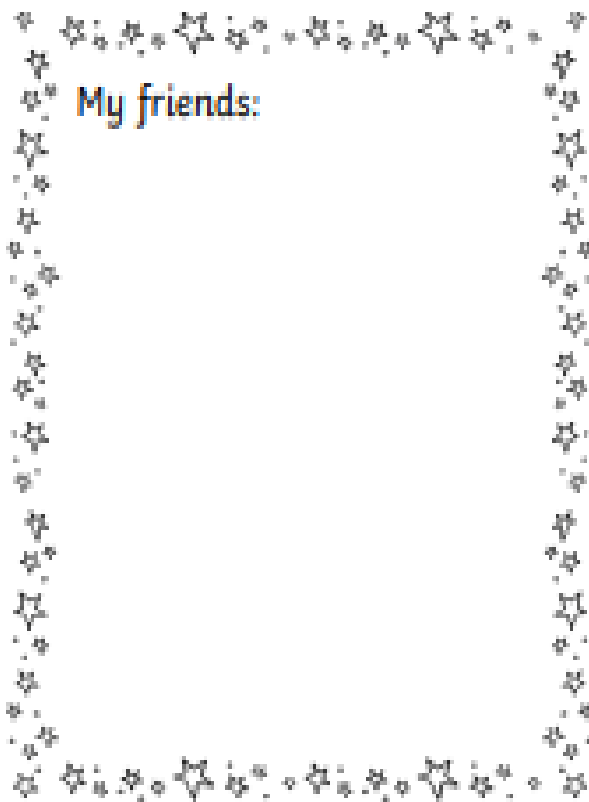

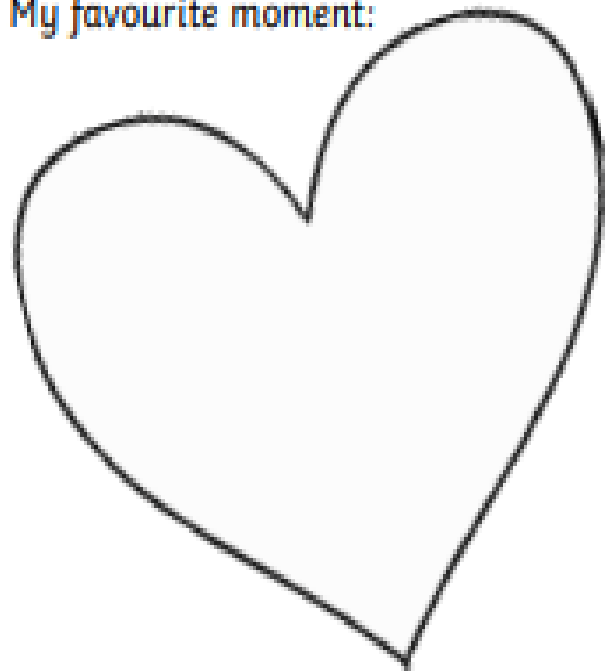

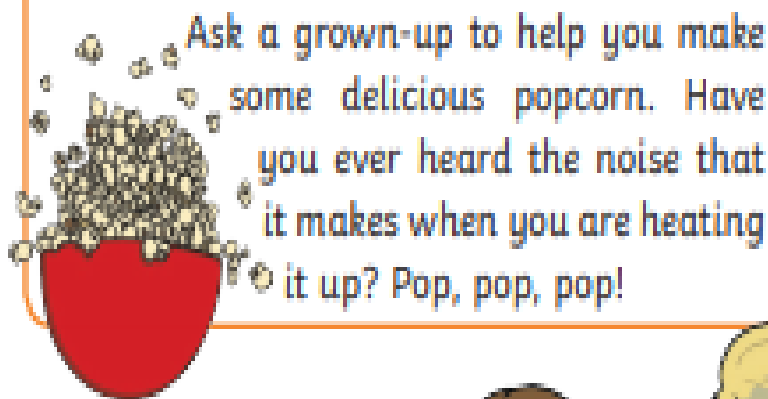
What I love the most about this year: _____

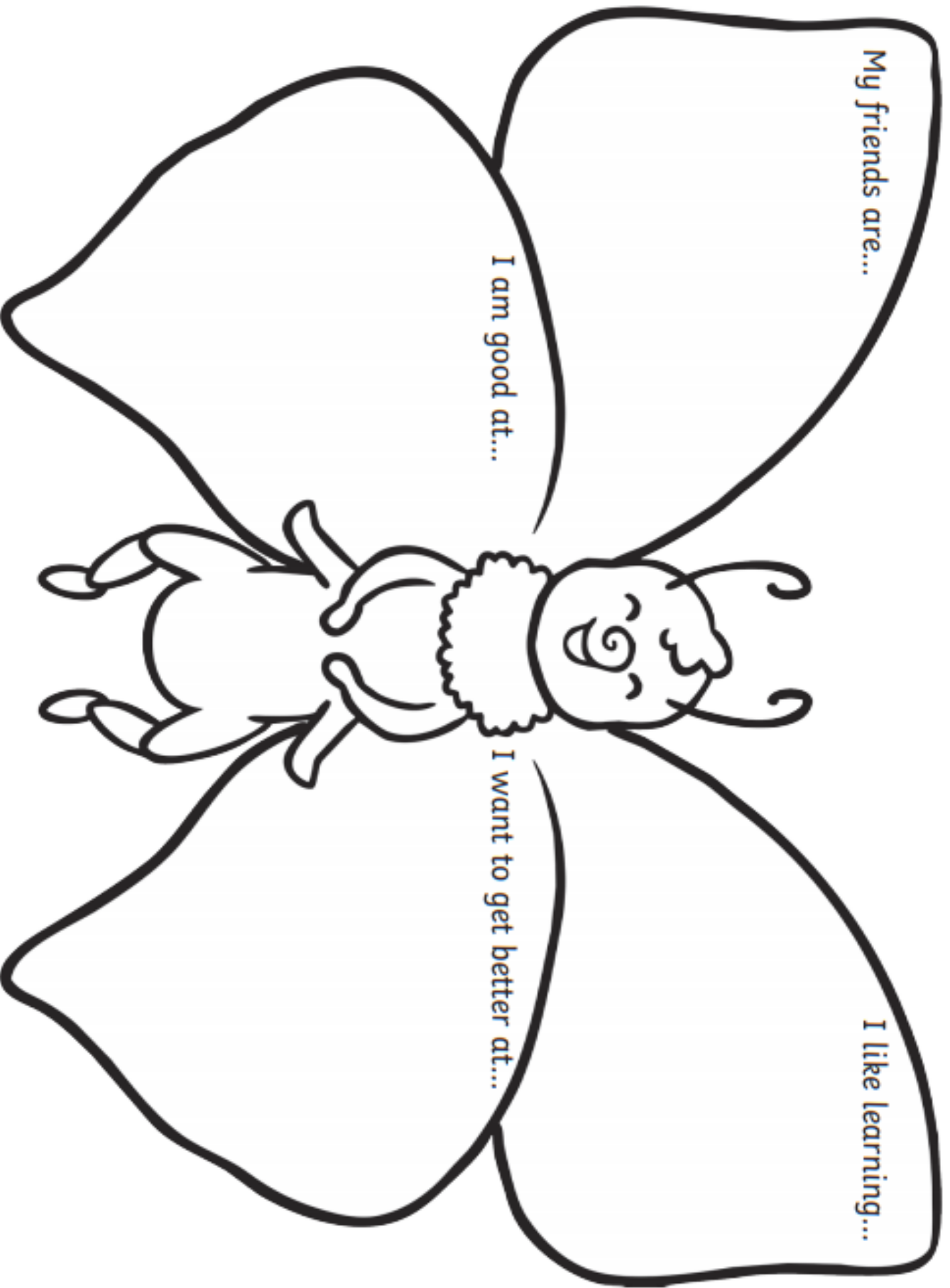

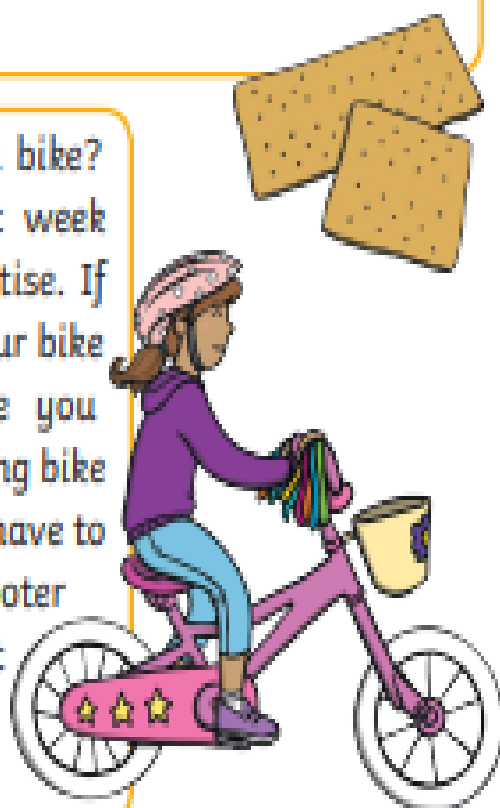

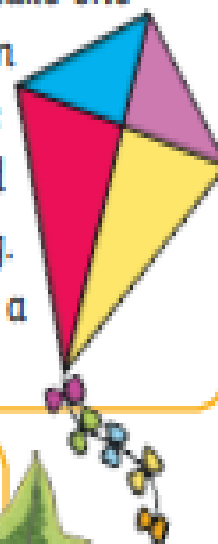


Holidays are a great time to do some baking. Work with a grown-up to make some tasty cakes and treats to share with your family and friends.

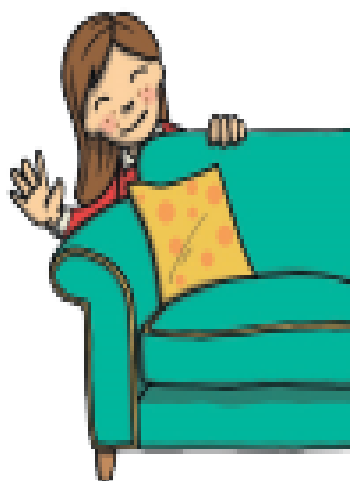

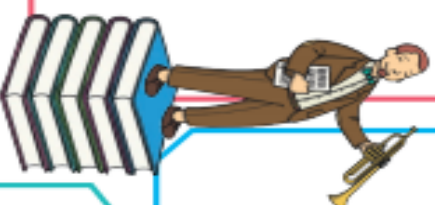
