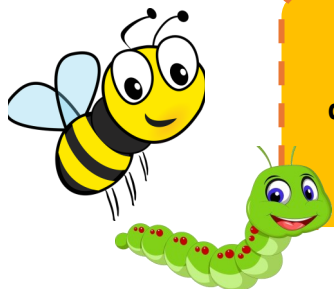

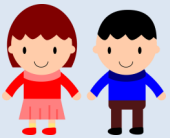
Our Curriculum

We plan our curriculum over 6 termly topics, where key skills are taught to enable children to achieve an end of subject composite task.

Our Topics

Autumn -

This is me!

Spring -

A World of Pure Imagination

English

English is planned around a story each week. Lessons are heavily phonic based to begin with and progress to sentence level.

Maths

We plan from the White Rose Maths scheme, where children work through progressive units of work that match the Early Years Curriculum.

Phonics & Reading (Little Wandle)

What will come home with your child and what will the communication about reading look like?



They will read 3 times a week in small groups of no more than 6 with a decodable Little Wandle book matched closely to their phonic ability. The book they read will be sent home as an E-Book to share and show off! This will be sent via Evidence -Me and will have a commentary of what they covered and learnt that week.

A decodable book of a similar level will be sent home and a library book to share. These 2 books will be changed on a set day, once a week every 6 weeks, the end of each half term – class teachers will check in with the physical book band going home and change if necessary. They will also respond to the home reading that has taken place and reward those that have done super home reading. We expect children to practise reading a minimum of 3 times a week at home, ideally more if possible.

Little but often is the key in Early Years.



Labelling Items

Please label your child's coat, shoes and cardigan/jumper as a minimum. Water bottle too is advised.
