Our Curriculum

We plan our curriculum over 3 termly topics, where key skills are taught to enable children to achieve an end of subject composite task.

Our Topics

Autumn -
We Are Explorers!



Spring -

English

We usually plan English lessons around a story / text. This enables the children to develop narrative skills and explore, develop and then dazzle in their writing.

Non-Fiction Writing, Poetry and other elements are taught over the year.

Maths

We plan from the White Rose Maths scheme, where children work through the following...

C = Concrete (using apparatus)

P = Pictorial (drawing)

A = Abstract (written methods)

Then develop reasoning skills.

Reading (Little Wandle)



What will come home with your child and what will the communication about reading look like?

They will read 3 times a week in small groups of no more than 6. The book they read will be sent home as an e-Book to share and show off! This will be sent via Evidence -Me and will have a commentary of what they covered and learnt that week.

A decodable book of a similar level will be sent home and a library book to share. These 2 books will be changed on a set day, once a week every 6 weeks, the end of each half term – class teachers will check in with the physical book band going home and change if necessary.

They will also respond to the home reading that has taken place. 1-1 reading and teacher comments will not be as frequent, they will be every 6 weeks.



Phonics Screening Check

In June your child will complete a statutory phonics assessment which assess their reading of real of nonsense words.

We will be preparing for this throughout the year so your child will be familiar with the assessment format.

There will be a workshop with more information during the Autumn term.
