Terrific Tigers and Charming Cheetahs Forest School

We are pleased to inform you that your child will take part in five Forest School sessions on Thursday afternoons. Please can your child come dressed in their Forest school clothes on the days of their sessions. Children may come in trainers, but please ensure that they bring wellington boots/walking boots with them to change into. The sessions will be led by Mr Fox and supported by our staff. By taking the children outside it encourages them to learn social, physical and educational skills whilst appreciating and understanding the woodland environment through a wide variety of activities and tasks geared for them. Activities include observing nature, making natural artwork, building shelters, using tools to make items with for example, cooking on a fire. The sessions are intended to be fun as well as giving the children a chance to learn in a safe environment.

Unfortunately, as this is England with very changeable weather it is impossible to say if it will be raining, snowing or sunny so please watch the weather forecast and then dress them appropriately.
