WHAT IS SEND?

SEND stands for special educational needs and disabilities. This can mean any disability, from physical to mental.

NEURODIVERGENT...

An umbrella term for anyone who has a difference in the way their brain functions. This can include Autism, ADHD, OCD, dyslexia, dyspraxia, Dyscalculia, epilepsy, Tourettes and much more.



OUR GOALS

Raise awareness & create more things to do & more understanding for our disabled community

Ensure professionals are trained & aware locally

Get funding for appropriate provision for SEND children in mainstream schools as a midway point

A much needed SEND school in Biddulph

The children of biddulph lost their SEND school many years ago and parents tried to fight for another, however that fight is still ongoing 20 years later.

Services have been cut to breaking point - getting any help for your child is a massive battle. Biddulph schools are doing their best and credit to them! But they just do not have the funding or resources to replace SEND provision, even though they are doing what they can in the midst of severe underfunding & cost of living crisis.

We need high quality, safe provision for our SEND children that only comes with a SEND specific school. The nearest SEND school for Staffordshire is leek & that is full for years. The surrounding schools are all full.
