Dear Parents/Carers

So, just over 30 years ago I ventured to Biddulph for the very first time on 26th May 1993. It was on this day that I was interviewed and appointed by Mr Cartlidge the Headteacher and governors as a Y4 teacher at Kingsfield First School. I can remember it as clear as yesterday, sitting in the staff room and being asked the usual questions...... However, towards the end of the interview one of the governors threw a curved ball question by asking for my opinions on whether prunes should be served at lunchtime! During the interview my sport was discussed as I played Korfball, had a rugby coaching certificate, was a swimming teacher and had a passion for tennis. I also had certificates for playing the piano which I later hugely regretted adding to my CV. Soon into my teaching career Mr Cartlidge asked if I would play the piano in a celebration assembly, of course, I said yes. However, regardless of the late-night practising, I made a total hash of playing a simple Hymn and Happy Birthday, so my sincere apologies if that was your birthday song spoilt and sorry for wasting the hard-earned money of my parents as the years of paying for private piano lessons was totally wasted! The memory though of Mrs Giannasi (a supply teacher at the time) calling me Les (you have to be a certain age to understand that joke) as I returned to my chair in that Awards Assembly, still makes me smile.

I started off teaching in Year 4, then Year 2, Reception and finally Nursery and taking on additional responsibilities along the way. When I began my teaching career, I did not plan on staying at Kingsfield for quite so long, it just happened. It probably happened for the same reason that many Biddulph born and bred people choose not to move away. Kingsfield First School is a small community of caring, hardworking families all dedicated to their children and it is this strength of community and togetherness that has made all my years at Kingsfield happy, fulfilled and beyond worthwhile. I am immensely proud to say I have been a teacher at Kingsfield and I am privileged to have become the Headteacher. Yes, I have seen many changes over the years in the buildings, the staffing, the curriculum, but one thing has remained constant - the joy of seeing children grow up and develop and then return as parents. When I was in my early career, I saw this happening to staff around me and can remember thinking, gosh they must be old teachers! Now, seeing as I have been experiencing this for a number of years, I thought if I don't go soon, children will be saying "you taught my Granny."

So, I arrived as Miss Gorton, I leave as Mrs Butler. During my teaching years I married and raised two wonderful children, my daughter is a London fashion designer for many high street clothing stores and my son is a GB swimmer, soon to be completing at the World Championships in Japan. Perhaps in my retirement I may rekindle my love for tennis and most of all enjoy time with my family.
