## Phonics & Reading (Little Wandle)

# What will come home with your child and what will the communication about reading look like?



They will read 3 times a week in small groups of no more than 6 with a decodable book matched closely to there phonic ability. A copy of the book they read in school will be sent home to share and show off! We will also update Evidence Me with a commentary of what they covered and learnt that week.

A library book will also be sent home to share. These are changed weekly on a Friday.





### English

English is planned around a story each week. Lessons are heavily phonic based to begin with and progress to sentence level.

#### Maths

We plan with a mastery approach where children work through progressive units of work that match the Early Years Curriculum.
