
Reading Across the Curriculum

From Y2 upwards (unless children are still accessing Little Wandle) we complete ERICA sessions. These texts are chosen for a variety of reasons. They may be an author focus base, genre focus or specifically linked to current learning. Within the sessions, children listen to adults who model reading, Responding to verbal comprehension questions. Read and explore the text to secure understanding,

new vocabulary and develop inference skills.

Our Leading Library

We have a wide selection of books in our library and the children enjoy accessing this to choose and select a 'Pleasure for Reading' book. These can be shared
