This week our spotlight is on our launch of Makaton!



Makaton is a way of talking with your hands. This allows children who struggle with communication and understanding to still interact with others.



At Kingsfield, we are taking a whole school approach to Makaton so that all children can be understood by those around them including staff and parents!

This week we had a 'No Pens Day' which celebrated the power of communication. This was the perfect opportunity to launch Makaton at Kingsfield. All the children and staff were shown our first two signs, **hello** and **goodbye**.



Each week, during celebration assembly, the children will be shown two new signs. These videos will then be uploaded onto our school website so parents can use the same signs as us.

Staff will encourage the children to use these signs throughout the week and as we continue to learn more.
