I am Miss Mohring, the SENDCo at Kingsfield, and my job is to ensure that all of our pupils with SEND have the best support and provision so that they can excel in all of their areas of need. My favourite part of my role as SENDCo is observing the children with SEND in the classroom to oversee their provision and support staff with the children's needs. Another significant part of my role as SENDCo is making referrals. These referrals often seek the advice of experts and externals agencies to improve and support the children's progress and provision.

Makaton

This term, we have taken a whole school approach to Makaton so that all children can be understood by those around them

including staff and parents!

Makaton is a way of talking with your hands which allows children who struggle with communication and understanding to still interact with others.
