Online safety-SEND pupils

1 in 3 young people have seen something worrying or nasty online. Pupils with SEN are more vulnerable to this risk.

NSPCC have partnered with Ambitious about Autism to bring online safety tips, advice and activities specifically for parents and carers of children with SEND. Parents may find letting their child go online to be intimidating; they might be worried about the different spaces their child explores, the people they meet digitally and the potential for things to go wrong.

Being online can be positive for children and young people, including those with additional needs. So much of our communication now happens online, either by messages, in a game or through a video call. Sometimes online platforms like the apps, social media sites and games children accesses can help them connect and make friends with new people that they might not know offline.

As a parent or carer, you play an important role in helping your child to have positive experiences online. If your child has additional needs, then this role can be even more important, and it can feel like a lot of responsibility when you hear about some of the risks young people face online. 


This week our spottight is on Times Tables!



Every month KS2 classes will be going head to head in a monthly TTRockstars tournament, where the winning class will get a special treat at the end of each month! So don't forget to log in as it is a class effort.







At Kingsfield, we are excited to announce we will now be awarding a TTRocker Of The Week!

This could be someone that has made a special effort to log into their TTRockstars and work on their times tables, the person with the most coins, most improved pupil, fastest speed or someone that has logged on the most.

Every pupil in KS2 has been sent home their own home pack of the times tables that they are working on. The more you practice these the quicker the children will get in recalling their number facts. As soon as they can answer a calculation within 6 seconds this will be removed from their pack until they are able to recall that times table fluently. When they have completed a times table they will be given a fresh set to work on in class and at home.











We have also signed up to Number Day 2024! This will be happening on the 2nd February where children will be asked to dress up in maths themed clothes (patterns, numbers, shapes, time etc). Please do not spend any money on costumes-we have attached some free ideas.

The children will be taking part in lots fun activities, including Buddy's challenge and the NSPCC Rocks with Times Table rocks. This is all in aid of raising funds for the NSPCC.
