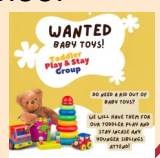
EYFS Intake September 2024

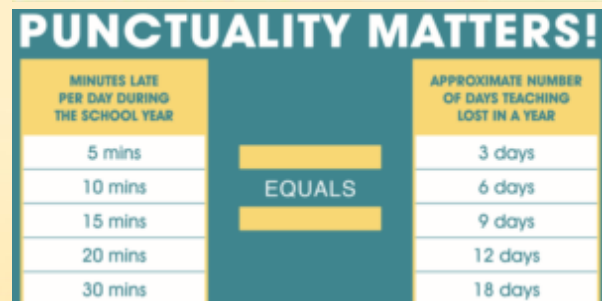
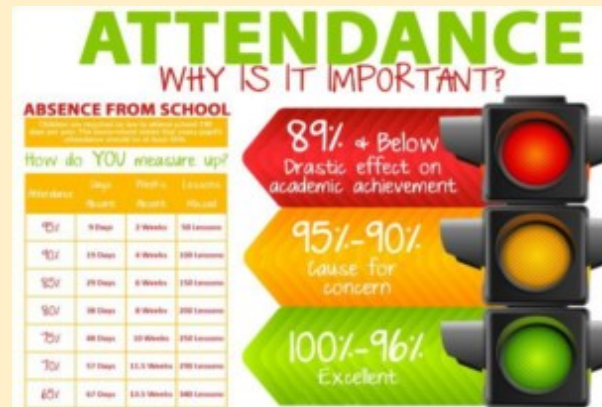


This week our spotlight is on attendance...
