Our Art Curriculum



Our Art curriculum is based on a range of skills covering: Drawing, Painting, Collage, Printing and Sculpture. We teach the children key skills which they then use to explore through different medium.

Art to EYFS

We use our art skills on a daily basis in EYFS and we love to explore many different areas of art including drawing and painting.

In Reception we are creating some budding artists during our 'Drawing Club' intervention linked to our Literacy!

Art to Key Stage 1

We have completed some fantastic art work in Key Stage 1 this year, drawing London Landmarks & learning how to draw Paddington Bear. We have used printing techniques to create a repeating pattern and more recently learnt how to collage.

We have used a lot of texture and pattern in our work.

Art in Key Stage 2

Our Key Stage 2 art this year has included a fabulous topic of the artist Wassily Kandinsky. His work is very eye catching, he uses colour, line, tone and shape in his work and the children have enjoyed creating their work in his style.












