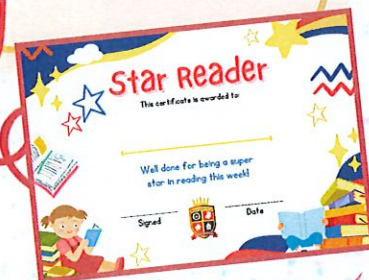

In Reception we are creating some budding artists during our 'Drawing Club' intervention linked to our Literacy!

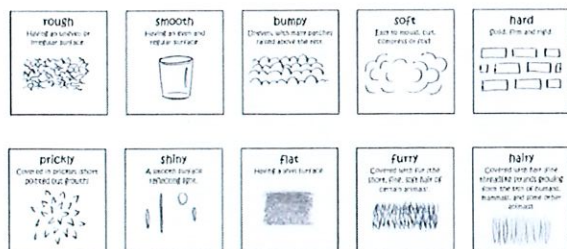


## Art in Key Stage 1

### Visual texture:

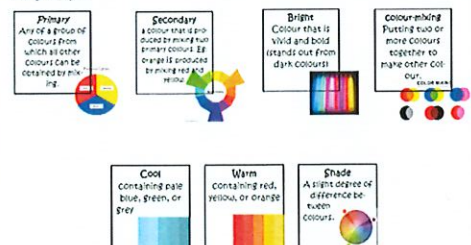


## Art in Key Stage 2
