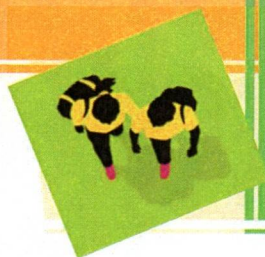




On Monday we walked for our mental health. It was great to enjoy the lovely weather and to feel the positive benefits.
