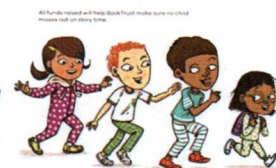
On Friday 27th June we will be taking part in this fundraiser for BookTrust.

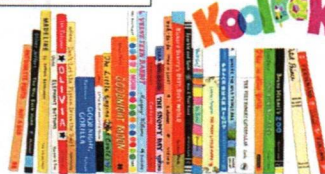

This year's festival theme is SPACE. Our opening parade starts at 11am followed by opening speeches and entertainment.

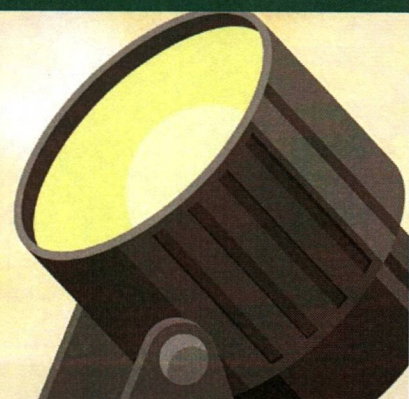
At 12pm the sand pit is opened alongside the fun fair, side stalls and attractions.

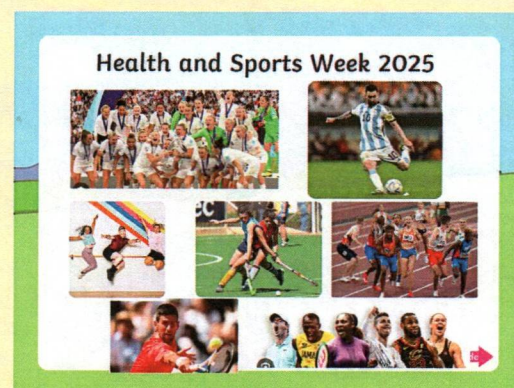
